The Art School hosts an annual artist in residence program and awards eight bursaries per year to local art students to further their artistic education through study at the Southampton Art School.

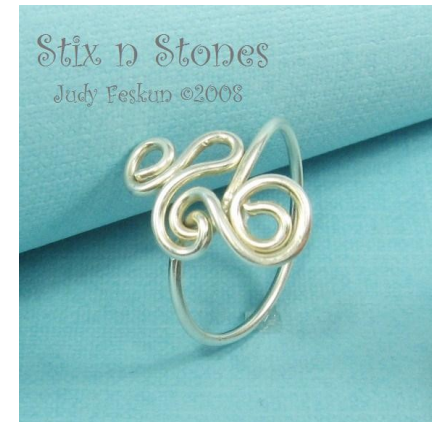
